

Taproot Theatre's *Babette's Feast* available to stream starting December 3

Delighting in-person audiences since opening in November, this Pacific Northwest debut will be available for those who must (or prefer to) stay home this season.

SEATTLE, WA – November 30, 2021 – Delighting in-person audiences since opening *Babette's Feast* in November, Taproot Theatre Company will make the production available for streaming December 3 through 30. Originally slated for spring of 2020, the Pacific Northwest debut of this new adaptation has proved especially timely after the pandemic curtailed public events and many private gatherings as well. *Babette's Feast* marked Taproot's return to live, in-person audiences, and the streaming option will now make the production available for patrons who must (or prefer to) stay home amid the continuing pandemic.

Crossing thousands of miles in search of asylum, Babette finds safety in a tiny mountain village. But petty squabbles and personal slights render the pious villagers as frigid and unforgiving as their surroundings. On one snowy December night, in an act of radical generosity, Babette prepares a feast so lavish that it awakens and transforms the brittle hearts in the village.

This theatrical adaptation of *Babette's Feast*, based on Isak Dinesen's short story, is directed by Scott Nolte, Taproot's co-founder and former Producing Artistic Director. Co-founder Pam Nolte plays Babette and is joined by a cast of Jenny Cross, James Faley, Jenny Vaughn Hall, Nolan Palmer, Kevin Pitman, April Poland, Matt Posner, and Teri Lee Thomas. The Noltes retired at the end of 2020, after 44 years with Taproot Theatre Company.

Tickets for the live productions are on sale now. Patrons can purchase the streaming option starting December 3 and must purchase by December 28.
