**Senior matinee performance of Pulitzer Prize-winning play, *Doubt, A Parable***

*April 23 at Taproot Theatre in Seattle's Greenwood neighborhood*

SEATTLE – February 11, 2008 – Taproot Theatre Company is offering a senior matinee performance of *Doubt, A Parable* on April 23 at 2:00 p.m. This Pulitzer Prize-winning play by John Patrick Shanley probes the mystery of uncertainty. When Sister Aloysius suspects wrongdoing at St. Nicholas school she instructs Sister James to keep a watchful eye. Her strong convictions set into motion a course of actions that could terminate Father Flynn. In the pursuit of truth, doubt shadows all certainty of the situation. Is Sister Aloysius right? Do convictions alone prove the accuracy of truth?
