Thank you for making 2017 such a rewarding and impactful year. Moving quickly from one project to the next, it's easy for me to miss the achievements our staff, artists and friends (like you) helped accomplish. Slowing down and taking a look back, we're grateful that:

- Every Jewell Mainstage and Isaac Studio production (7 plays) exceeded attendance goals.
- We had a record-breaking one million dollars in tickets sold.
- Our Education & Outreach programs exceeded their goals in registrations and tours.
- Our family of financial supporters grew by nearly 50%!

It's been a long-term goal to develop new works for the American theatre, and in 2017 we premiered two plays and one musical: *Evidence of Things Unseen, Persuasion* and *Relativity.* Helping nurture scripts that reflect our core values and seeing them picked up for production at other theatres is tremendously exciting.

The Taproot staff is energized as we begin 2018 with a surge in season subscribers, a solid school touring schedule for the Road Company, great classes for kids through

seniors and compelling plays for the 2018 Season. And as we enter our 42nd year of service, we're laying the groundwork for a 3-year plan that will guide our artistic programming, finances and facilities.

May I say thank you again? It's a rare thing for a theatre to survive this long, let alone thrive. Your trust and generosity is so vital to our ability to serve boldly, to take risks on new scripts, and to do everything we can to create a vibrant welcoming space for audiences, students and guest artists. On behalf of our Board of Directors, staff and artists, God bless you for your partnership in Taproot Theatre Company's artistry and service.
