Sarah, Be, and Faith Bennett Russell have performed on stages in the Seattle area for a number of years. All three together worked most recently on *Mamma Mia!* at Village Theatre this summer, with Faith directing, and Sarah and Be on stage. They're some of Seattle's greatest performers, but they've never performed on the same stage together—until now. Experience the talent of the Russell family as they share stories and songs. The cabaret is directed by **Jimmy Shields**, with music direction by **Aaron M. Davis Norman**.
